

Guidelines for Oral and Poster Presentations

Oral Presentations

Each oral presentation is allocated a total of **15 minutes**:

- **10 minutes for the presentation**
- **5 minutes for questions and discussion**

We kindly ask all speakers to respect the allocated time to ensure that the scientific programme runs according to schedule. Session chairs will provide a warning shortly before the end of the presentation time and may need to stop presentations that exceed the allocated 10 minutes.

Presentation recommendations

- Please prepare your presentation in **PowerPoint (.pptx) format**.
- Use sufficiently large fonts.
- Figures, photographs, maps, and graphs should be clearly visible and readable from a distance.
- Please clearly acknowledge collaborators, institutions, and funding sources where appropriate.
- Please check your presentation in advance and make sure that all videos, animations, fonts, and other media are correctly embedded.
- Presenters should send their presentation to the organisers **by Friday, 4 September 2026**. Please send it to the official email 14iwbs@agr.hr

The **5-minute discussion period** is intended to encourage questions, exchange of experience, and scientific discussion with the audience.

Poster Presentations

Posters should be prepared in **A0 format, portrait orientation**.

Poster dimensions:

- Width: **841 mm (84.1 cm)**
- Height: **1189 mm (118.9 cm)**
- Orientation: **Portrait**

Please do not prepare posters in landscape orientation or in a format larger than A0, as the available poster boards are designed for A0 portrait posters.

Poster mounting should be done by participants with the help of the present staff. Please respect the assigned poster number/location, which will be provided by the organisers on-site.
